## SAME GREAT PERIMETER. NEW AND IMPROVED INTERCHANGE.



*Transform 285/400 Project*

Led by the Georgia Department of Transportation, the I-285 at GA 400 interchange is undergoing a major upgrade over a 4-year coordinated construction period that will add roadway capacity, improve traffic flow, safety and access, and generate opportunity for new investment in the Perimeter area. Construction for the project is scheduled for completion in 2020.

## 10.5 MILES OF TRANSFORMATION

- 4.3 miles of upgrades on I-285, from Roswell Road to Ashford Dunwoody Road,
- 6.2 miles on GA 400, from Glenridge Connector to Spalding Drive.
- Improvements include:
  - New barrier separated collector distributor lanes
  - Reconstruction of the Abernathy Road interchange as well as existing ramps and bridges in the interchange area
  - Replacement of the bridge at Mt. Vernon Highway
  - New flyover bridges
