
A search for more space and better transit access led Insight Global to plant their flag in Central Perimeter with their Dunwoody HQ. To ensure they were making the most of this new investment, they partnered with Perimeter Connects to understand the needs of their employees and develop programs that connected their workforce with the amenities that brought them to the Central Perimeter submarket.

PERIMETER CONNECTS SERVICES:

- Pre-move workforce commute survey and analysis to determine pain-points and opportunities in current and future commutes
- Custom "Welcome to Transit" guide for employees
- Bespoke Insight Global commute webpage, with details on accessing the new office by train, bus, car, or foot
- In partnership with Twelve24, Perimeter Connects offered a workforce "Try Transit" campaign, distributing more than 270 free 10-trip transit passes to Insight Global employees in advance of move-in

RESULTS:

- Perimeter Connects supported Insight Global leadership in developing proactive relocation messaging, as well a a clear benefit structure for their many intown employees (35% of employees lived close to transit, and 67% were interested to try transit as a commute option)
- 100% of employees interested in transit received a transit pass through their "Try Transit" campaign
- 196 employees have accessed resources via the Insight Global commute webpage


OneTrust relocated from Midtown to Perimeter to maintain transit access but expand their recruiting potential to a broader age range. Supporting the growth and development of their workforce and being able to continue to recruit more entry-level talent made transit access critical.

PERIMETER CONNECTS SERVICES:

- Anonymized mapping of OneTrust's existing workforce against a travel time analysis to identify employees likely to experience meaningful negative impacts due to the relocation and quantify the overall impact on travel times and access for current workforce
- Commuter benefits benchmarking against comparable tech companies in metro Atlanta
- Comprehensive, data-driven commuter program and policy recommendations

RESULTS:

- Mapping and analysis were used to support internal retention strategies during relocation.
- HR leadership used the data to secure buy-in for a 100% subsidy for transit - matching that provided by NCR, VMware, Salesforce, Mailchimp, and other comparable tech companies in the region and helping them showcase accessible for employees facing a longer commute from intown locations.
- Implementation of competitive transit benefits allowed OneTrust to support higher office densities without running into typical parking pinches associated with their high-density floorplans.





Perimeter Connects began working with WestRock early in their relocation from Norcross to Sandy Springs. With a major deciding factor for their move to Central Perimeter being access to improved commutes, their partnership with PC helped position them to make the most of local transportation amenities.

- More than 85 carpoolers were matched, with 13 carpool receiving incentives for new commutes
